Activities and stimuli will be delivered via the seven areas of learning within the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) framework which include;

Communication and language - physical development - personal, social & emotional development - literacy - mathematics - understanding the world - expressive arts and design

The cost is £60 per week per child for Mon to Fri places or £14 per child, per session for odd days.

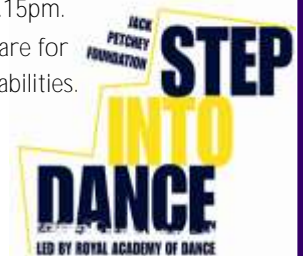


Step into Dance
