Curriculum

Over the next half term we will be covering the following:

Literacy - Poetry, Non-fiction: report writing, Fiction Text: The Snail and the Whale.

Numeracy - Measuring weight, length and capacity. Multiplication and division.

Science - 'Materials' and 'Forces'.

ICT - Creating pictures. Using the keyboard to type and developing mouse control to navigate.

Art & DT - Investigation materials, printing and painting, exploring different textures, collage and construction.

PSHE (Planet You) - Changes.

R.E. - Judaism.

P.E. - Dance, gymnastics and ball games.

History - History of space travel.

Geography - Learning about festivals around the world.

Reading!

Reading books will continue to be changed every week. Please ensure your child continues to read regularly at home.

Please use the reading record booklet to record any tricky words your child needs to practise and encourage them to write about their favourite part of the book too.

The reading record booklet should be returned everyday. Please ensure you look after the reading books and you return them in good condition.

Our Targets

Reading-

To use phonetic knowledge as a prime approach to reading.

To be able to answer comprehension questions based on the text.

To recognise high-frequency words.

Writing-

To form letters correctly.

To write sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

To use phonics sounds to spell unfamiliar words.

To use adjectives and connectives in sentences.

To begin to write in paragraphs.

Maths-

To be able to measure weight, length and capacity.

To be able to solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division using concrete objects and pictorial representations.
