Curriculum

Literacy: In Literacy our core book this half term will be 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey. We will be writing stories with a familiar settings. Please feel free to purchase the book so that you can read it with your child at home.

Maths: We will be learning to tell the time to 15 minutes. We will also learn multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

ICT: We will use iPads to create comic strips and will use computers to retrieve information about toys.

Science: We will investigate materials and forces in relation to toys.

Our Targets

Reading

To say the sound when shown any grapheme taught so far.

To read fluently with attention to a range of punctuation.

To predict what will happen next in a story based on what has happened so far.

Writing

To write in sentences using capital letters and full stops correctly.

To extend sentences with conjunctions such as because, and, or, then.

To use the present and the past tense correctly.

To proof read to check for errors in spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Maths

To count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s

To recall the 2, 5 and 10 times table.

To use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line

To tell the time to 15 minutes
