This is a science based topic where the children will be learning about animals and their habitats.

Curriculum

Over the next half term we will be covering the following:

Literacy - Writing non-chronological reports about British Woodlands.

Numeracy - Adding and subtracting 2 digit and 1 digit numbers. Solving practical money problems, including giving change. Recognise odd and even numbers. Multiplying and dividing by 2, 5 and 10.

Science –Pants and animals living in forests and other habitats. How to sort living things into different groups. What a micro-habitat is and what creatures live there. How animals are adapted to their environment. How living things depend on each other.

ICT - Safely searching for information on the internet.

PSHE - Changes

R.E. –Christianity-Easter and symbols

P.E. - Basketball
