This is a geography based topic where the children will be learning about the planet and using maps.

## Curriculum

Over the next half term we will be covering the following:

**Literacy** - Our core book this half term is *The Pea and the Princess* by Mini Grey. The children will be writing traditional tales with a twist. They will learn to write different types of sentences e.g. commands, statements, questions and exclamations. They will also be learning to recite and perform a variety of poetry.

**Numeracy** - Partitioning numbers, adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers, multiplication and division facts and measuring volume and capacity.

**Geography**-Physical and human features of particular localities. The world including continents and countries. The environment and how to look after it.

**ICT** - Algorithms and programming
