This is a science based topic where the children will be learning about plants.

Curriculum

Over the next half term we will be covering the following:

Literacy - Classical poetry (The Owl and the Pussycat). The children will listen to, innovate and write their own poems using thematic poetry as a framework.

Numeracy - To recognise and find fractions of amounts. To measure lengths, mass and capacity. To read the time to 5 minutes and intervals of time. To add and subtract 2 digit and 2 digit numbers.

Science - To identify ways of finding out about scientific issues. To name parts of a plant. To know what plants need to grow and survive
