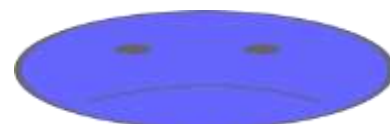

Your children will be cared for by a qualified team of staff who will offer a relaxing, stimulating and safe environment. Children will be placed in age appropriate small groups and managed by keyworkers. Activities and stimuli will be delivered via the seven areas of learning within the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) framework which include;

Communication and language - physical development - personal, social & emotional development - literacy - mathematics - understanding the world - expressive arts and design

The cost is £60 per week per child for Mon to Fri places or £14 per child, per session for odd days.

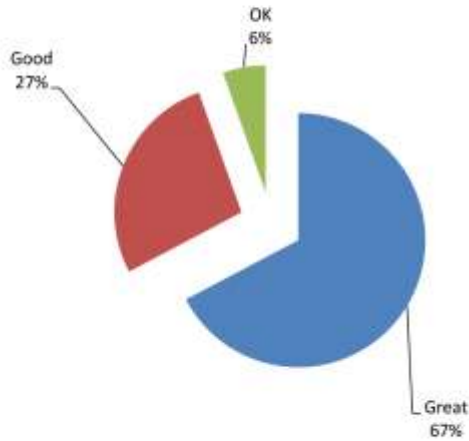
A range of snacks will be provided which will include sandwiches, wraps, pitta bread together with fresh fruit, vegetables and a healthy drink.

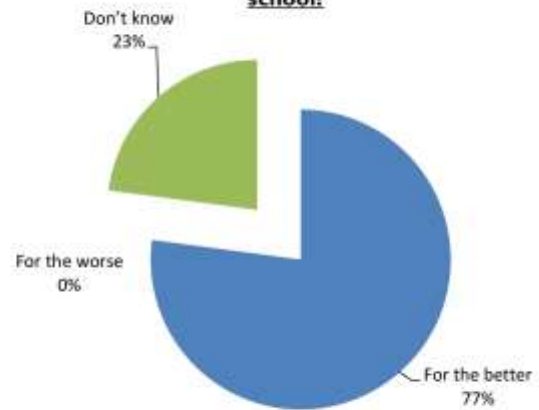

At the end of our open evening on Tuesday, we asked our guests some questions about their choices, perceptions and impressions of Buxton School. This is what you told us.....

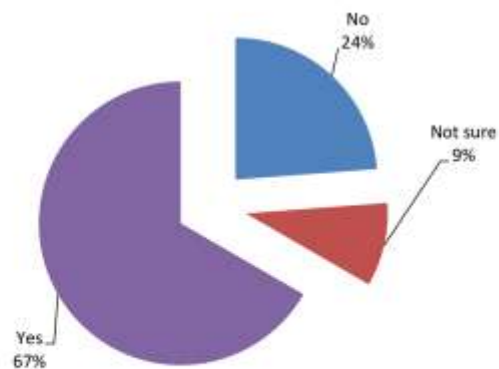
What is your impression of Buxton school?
