

The bulk of the work occurs during November, February, May and June, with odd extra days possible at other times of year as required. Exams begin on 15<sup>th</sup> May and there will be a training session in the previous week at which you will get to meet the rest of the team as well as receiving induction in procedures and exam regulations.
