Welcome back to the final half term of this academic year. We hope you had an enjoyable half term break and the children are ready to continue with our Geography based topic:

Different Places, Similar Lives.



Last half term we looked at the world in general and focussed on a few individual countries, researching them in detail. This half term we will be looking at maps; reading them, understanding symbols and even creating our own.

Curriculum

Over this half term, we will be covering the following:

Literacy - work based on 'Gregory Cool' by Caroline Binch.

During this unit we will look at the **biography** aspect of the book and also at the set-up and structure of **letter writing**.

Reading - The Sheep-Pig by Dick King Smith

(3TS and 3SC)

Gangsta Granny by David Walliams

(3CA and 3PM)

Spellings - Continue work on apostrophes as contractions, continue work on homophones, sounds: **y** (i sound) **ee**, **ou**, **gh**, suffix **ly** and a variety of spelling strategies including letter shapes, pyramids, trace copy check and look say cover write check.

Numeracy

Addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers (including money) using formal written methods with regrouping in tens and hundreds columns.

Multiplication and division of 2-digit and 1-digit numbers using formal written methods with regrouping.

Measurement including:

Capacity and Volume: measure, compare and add and subtract volume and capacity in l and ml.

Time: read and write the time on 12-hour analogue and digital clocks in seconds, minutes and hours.

PLEASE HELP YOUR CHILD LEARN THEIR TIMES TABLES. BY THE END OF YEAR 3 ALL CHILDREN SHOULD KNOW 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 AND 10 TIMES TABLES AND RELATED DIVISION FACTS.

Homework

Maths and Literacy homework is given out every **Wednesday** and is to be returned the following **Wednesday** to the children's Literacy and Maths teachers.

Your child is also expected to read daily and this must be recorded in a reading record. Reading records are collected in on Tuesday and Friday.
